Public voices are calling for **participatory behavior** on the part of the elderly themseves.

Learning in Later Life is a prerequisite for different forms of social participation.

Self-organized and self-determined projects are aiming to force self-help institutions on local level.



- Participation means that elderly are using free spaces of society for awareness in public and political issues and so older people could influence decision-making authorities.
- Self-determination: Older people work autonomously aiming to gain competence for forming decision-making bodies for issues of their own interests.



 Participation models are community-oriented reflecting the living environment of those affected.

 Productivity projects: These include the productive use of ageing for the general interest.

 They combine elements of learning, self-help, and volunteering.



A lifeworld-related participation of older people arises through:

- ... Learning in later life in different settings,
- ... Initiatives and activism of the elderly themselves,
- ... Transparent information for older people in matters that affect them,
- ... Awareness and public relations want to make the potential of older people visible



 ... Changing the negative image of old age by including older people in the process,

... Revitalizing and incorporating the life experience of older people in society,

 ... Promotion of intergenerational understanding - younger people benefit from the experience of older people, and older people learn to deal with new realities,



 ... Taking in account the heterogeneity of older people by promoting projects and initiatives for specific target groups and subject areas.

- ... Supporting organizations and individual networks to inform the public about the importance of socio-cultural issues in the post-professional phase of life.
- ... Learning how to be heard by the public!



 ... Socio-political participation is a right and duty for all age groups by learning how to do it!

 ... Promoting a cross-generational view of sociopolitical activities, habits, needs and interests in all phases of life.

- ... Putting Senior Interests on European Level by taking the possibilities seriously of
- taking part in the upcoming elections!

Elephants as a symbol for solidarity among generations

Elephants are said to attain old age and wisdom.
